NEWS FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION:

The **Social Security Administration** has announced an increase in disability benefits for 2015. The increase will be 1.7%. For those who receive SSI, Supplemental Security Income, the new rate will be \$733 monthly. PERSON-CENTERED PLANNING (PCP) FOR PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES:

Person-centered plans help create a roadmap for people with intellectual disabilities to have the life they want to live. **Isabel Sturman,** a mom with two children with special needs, is a Certified Planning Facilitator who has graciously offered to create a limited number of plans for TASK families at no cost (usually \$75-\$150). APPLIED BEHAVIORAL ANALYSIS (ABA)

ABA is often used in the treatment of children with **autism.** Yet, many Oregon insurance companies have not provided coverage for this. Community activists and organizations such as the Autism Society of Oregon have advocated strongly for change. To their credit, recent changes in Oregon law may allow for ABA to be covered, so be sure to check with your insurer for changes, which is effective January, 2015. Note too that some insurance companies may offer retroactive reimbursement for ABA expenses as of August, 2014.
