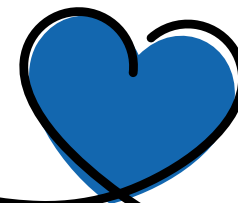

Connecting the community

Agency events brought hundreds in our community together, to learn, serve, celebrate and just be. JFCS, in partnership with Congregation Beth Israel, helped bring back the Community Seder after its three-year pandemic hiatus. We spearheaded a number of support-group opportunities that met at the Mittleman Jewish Community Center. And JFCS invited PSU Professor Natan Meir to offer "Soviet Jews Under Nazi Rule," a lecture followed by an interactive Q&A. JFCS also connected through programs and services with Portland Area Jewish Educators (PAJE), Congregation Neveh Shalom and the Eastside Jewish Commons.

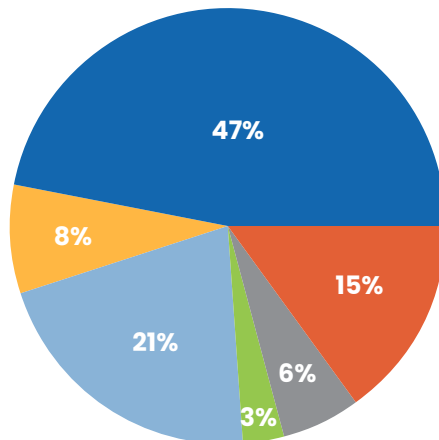
